1. Information We Collect

We collect the following information when you enroll or contact us:

- Student and parent/guardian names
- Contact information (address, phone, email)
- Date of birth (for age-appropriate class placement)
- Payment information (processed securely — we do not store full card numbers)
- Emergency contact information
- Health/medical information relevant to safe participation

2. How We Use Your Information

We use your information to:

- Process enrollment and tuition payments
- Communicate class schedules, updates, and announcements
- Send newsletters and promotional emails (you may opt out at any time)
- Ensure student safety during classes and events

3. How We Protect Your Information

- We maintain reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect your personal information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure.
- Payment information is processed through secure, encrypted payment processors.
- We do not sell or share your personal information with third parties for marketing purposes. Access to health/medical information is limited to staff who need it to ensure safe participation. In the event of a data breach affecting your private information, we will notify affected individuals as required by applicable New York law, including the New York SHIELD Act.

4. Photography & Video

- We may use photos/videos of students for our website or social media. For students under 13, we will only do so with verifiable parental/guardian consent.
- You may opt out by contacting us at tiffany@tsdpac.com.

5. Children's Privacy

- We are committed to protecting the privacy of children under 13 in accordance with the federal Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA).
- We collect information about minors only as necessary for enrollment and safety, and only with verifiable parental/guardian consent. Parents/guardians may review the personal information we have collected about their child, request that it be deleted, and refuse to permit further collection or use of their child's information by

contacting us at tiffany@tsdpac.com. We do not condition a child's participation on the disclosure of more information than is reasonably necessary.

6. Third-Party Services

We may use third-party tools (such as email marketing or payment processors) that have their own privacy policies. We encourage you to review those policies.

7. Your Rights

To the extent required by applicable law, you have the right to:

- Request a copy of the information we hold about you
- Request corrections to inaccurate information
- Request deletion of your information (subject to legal and business requirements)
