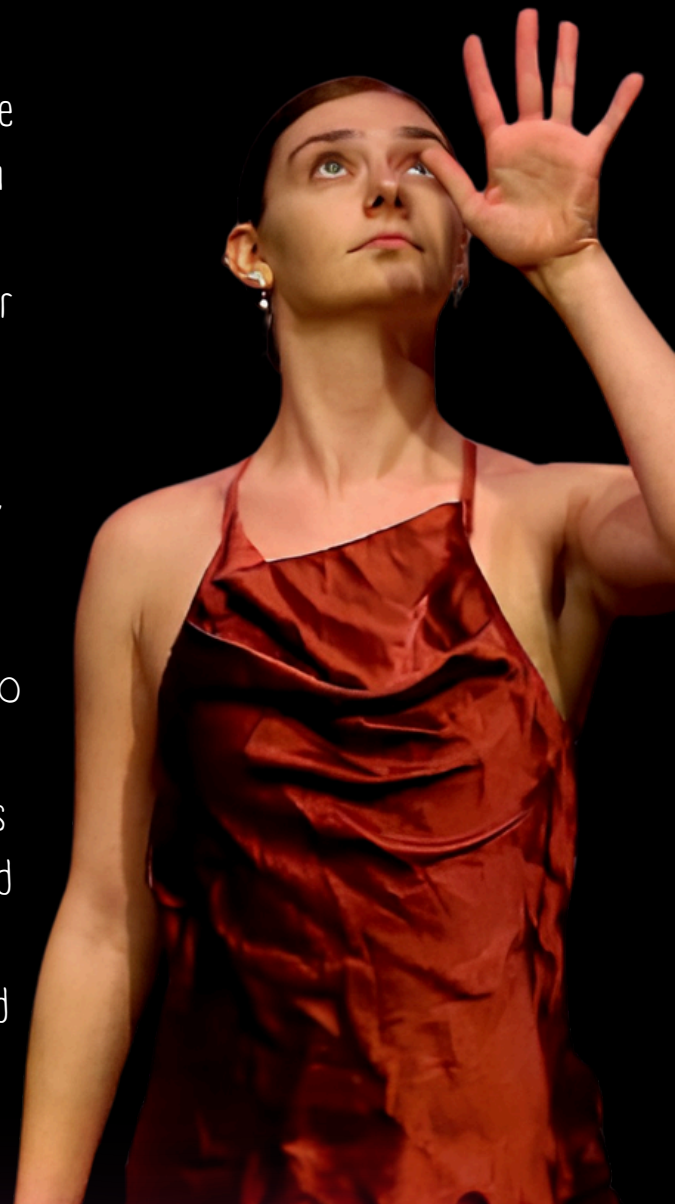


# MOVEMENT WEEK
