Dress Rehearsal Schedule for Thursday, June 27th at the Landmark Theatre:

Attached you will find a document with your Show assignment as well as your dress rehearsal time. If you are performing in multiple shows, please see the dress rehearsal sheet to see which show you will be rehearsing in. A more detailed e-mail about parking and entering the Landmark will be sent out as we get closer to the show.

*These are the times for all of the dress rehearsals, you will only be asked to attend one of them. You will find that in the attached file.

- 9:00am-12:14pm Dress Rehearsal for the Awaken Show on 6/27
- 1:00pm-3:36pm Dress Rehearsal for the Enliven Show on 6/27
- 4:00pm-7:32pm Dress Rehearsal for the Thrive Show on 6/27
- Please arrive 30 minutes prior to your dress rehearsal time slot. If your student is only in Act 2 for that show, they may arrive 30 minutes before their Act 2 time slot.

Dress Rehearsal Information:

- Student's will need to wear their costumes. They will not need to have hair and/or make up for dress rehearsal. Dress rehearsal will be for students to get familiar with the space, come up on the stage, space out their dances, and know where to go.
- Dancers will enter through the performer's Entrance on West Jefferson Street.
- Whether you send your dancer fully dressed or not, please report to your assigned dressing room after entering into the performer's entrance.
- **If you plan on Volunteering backstage for the Show, you will need to also volunteer at Dress Rehearsal.** Parents not volunteering will drop their children off at dress rehearsal and walk to the front of the building to enter the Theatre and pick up once they are done at the Artist Entrance.
- Dancers will stay with their group and go to their dressing rooms throughout dress rehearsal.
- Dancers will be allowed to leave as soon as all of their routines have rehearsed on stage.

- Be sure to give us your message. ex) "Sally, we are so excited to see everything you've worked on this year! Your joy is infectious and fills the stage! Love, Mom and Dad"
- Also be sure to give us the photo you would like to use and we will insert into an ad for you. You can also create your own ad and send it as well just be sure it's sized appropriately for an 8.5 x 11 sheet of paper divided accordingly.

Backstage Volunteers:

Each year we have volunteers backstage to help with our Minis and Petites. Backstage Volunteers will be an extra set of eyes and hands with the dancers before, during, and after their stage performance. Since the Landmark is a bigger theatre, we are asking for more volunteers. We have also added volunteers for some of our Acro classes as well as our younger competition teams. Please note: Backstage volunteers will be escorting the dancers to the stage either via an elevator or stairs. We will have one volunteer at the front of the dancer line and one at the end of the line. The third volunteer will be additional help with getting kids to and from the stage. We will not be able to have male volunteers backstage for the Recital.

As a backstage volunteer you can watch your dancer's performance from the wings (no purchase of ticket necessary) as well as there will be monitors in every room to watch the performance from. Once the dancers are done with their stage time, backstage volunteers will escort the dancers back to their room to keep eyes in the dressing room.
