

Subject Line: 🌟 Dress Rehearsal Schedules and Information

Good Afternoon TSDPAC Families,

Recital Weekend is almost here, and we couldn't be more excited to celebrate your dancers and all the hard work they've put in this season! Below are the final details to help you prepare for both **Dress Rehearsal (Saturday, June 20)** and **Recital Day (Sunday, June 21)** at the **Landmark Theater**.

You can find your dancer's show assignment by logging into your Parent Portal at www.tsdpac.com. Once logged in, click "View Performances" from the main menu. This will show you your dancer's assigned show(s). After that, return to the homepage and click the "**Reverie**" graphic to access our recital hub. Scroll to the bottom of the page to find detailed info for each show – **Wonder, Imagine, Dream**– including schedules, costume checklists, call times, volunteer info, and more. Your dress rehearsal schedules will be listed there as well.

Arrival & Parking:

When arriving at the Landmark Theater, street parking as well as garage parking is available. You can find all the different options for parking [HERE!](#)

After parking, please bring your dancer(s) to the Artist Entrance of the Landmark Theatre located on West Jefferson Street (you will see The Most Museum from the door) for drop off on Saturday/Sunday. You may use the front entrance for ticket scanning upon entering on Sunday. This is the only area that we will utilize as our secure Entrance and Exit (for both Dress Rehearsal and Recital) for dancers to enter.

Our staff as well as a security guard will be present upon your arrival to assist in safely and warmly welcoming dancers. There are assigned dressing rooms and performer restrooms backstage that we have listed on your dress rehearsal schedule. These dressing rooms will be labeled by class and teacher. Upon drop off we ask that only one female adult assists their dancer in the dressing area to avoid crowding and respect others privacy. Our pre-assigned backstage volunteers as well as staff will be backstage with dancers throughout the Recital on Sunday.

What to Bring:

Please label all costumes, shoes, and accessories, and pack them in a clearly marked dance bag along with a water bottle. Tidy, non-messy snacks are allowed to keep your dancer fueled. Please encourage your dancer to keep their dressing area neat as costumes need to be stage ready. Our staff and volunteers will be there to assist dancers with anything they need. If you are still interested in volunteering backstage, you can sign up at www.tsdpac.com by clicking on "Reverie" and selecting your dancer's show.


Dress Rehearsal – Saturday, June 20:

Dancers should arrive 30 minutes before their scheduled rehearsal time, dressed in their costume. Hair and makeup are **not required** for rehearsal. The purpose of this rehearsal is for dancers to become familiar with the stage, practice entrances and exits, and feel comfortable in the theater environment. Dress rehearsal slots are very specific so please plan to arrive on time so we can ensure all dancers hit the stage with their class.

Once you drop off your dancer at the Artist Entrance or dressing room, you'll be asked to exit and re-enter through the **main front entrance** to wait in the lobby or theater. You may pick your dancer up from their dressing room after they've completed all of their routines. Dancers do not need to stay once all of their dances have rehearsed on stage.

Recital Day – Sunday, June 21:

On recital day, dancers must arrive **45 minutes prior to showtime**, fully dressed with hair and makeup already done. **Dancers will remain backstage for the entire show** (unless in the wings getting ready to perform) with their teacher and class volunteers. This helps us ensure safety, smooth transitions, and allows dancers to be in place for the final curtain call.

 Please note: **We cannot accommodate early sign-outs** during the show for safety and flow. As our full staff will be focused on the show.

Following curtain call, **Mini dancers will remain on stage for dismissal**. One parent/guardian must come to the stage to sign them out. Teachers will have class rosters, and you'll be asked to initial next to your dancer's name. **Petite, Junior and Teen/Senior dancers** will be dismissed from their dressing rooms backstage and can be met there by a parent or guardian to collect belongings and exit. We kindly ask that you check your Petite, Junior, Teen, Senior dancer out with a TSDPAC staff member that will be stationed in the hallway outside your dancers dressing room.

Tickets:

Tickets are being sold through **Ticketmaster**, as required by the Landmark Theater. Sales began **Monday, May 4th at 10:00 AM**.

Ticket pricing (before fees) is as follows:

- Adults: \$30–\$38
- Children: \$20–\$28
- Children under 2: Free if seated on a lap

We've worked hard to keep our prices consistent with previous seasons, while also giving our dancers the opportunity to perform in such a beautiful, professional space.

From our friends at the Landmark Theater in regards to purchasing tickets:

Least expensive is in person at the Landmark Theatre Box Office. (Mon-Fri 10am-5pm)

Next is over the phone with us (315.475.7979 option 3). We charge \$6 per ticket over the phone. Depending on how close it is to the performance we will either mail the tickets or hold them at the box office.

Most convenient but most expensive would be online at [Ticketmaster.com](https://www.ticketmaster.com).

Ticketmaster has a convenience charge of \$5.85 - \$10.45 per ticket (depending on the price of the ticket). It will list the pricing with all the fees included.

An important thing to note is there is a \$4 facility fee no matter how tickets are purchased!

We are so proud of our dancers and can't wait to watch them shine on such a historic and beautiful stage. Thank you for your support and trust throughout this season—it means everything to us.
